Help needed more than ever

Children everywhere, from all walks of life, will be **living in poverty this Christmas**.

Families who were able to manage just a few months ago are now having to choose whether to **HEAT or EAT**.

The price of food, fuel and other essentials has risen, but **wages for most people have seen a real-terms cut**.

Christmas is something they can't even begin to afford.

Who we help

Charlie lives with his mum and two younger siblings who were all victims of domestic abuse. They were in the process of moving to a new home, and finances were a struggle. Gifts from Mission Christmas meant that the children had a visit from Santa, with the presents really bringing to life how magical Christmas should be. With help from Cash for Kids, a real Father Christmas was able, for the first time, to deliver presents to the children in a safe space just for them. They made memories to last a lifetime.

> Mum struggles to provide daily essentials for her children, and has previous debt due to financial abuse stemming from domestic violence. Christmas was going to be a big struggle. Thanks to the support from Mission Christmas, mum had some pressure relieved which had a positive impact on her mental health. The children were proud to show off their new toys. -Safeguarding Organisation

Amy is a young carer for her mum, who has a condition that limits her mobility. Mum told her support worker that she was worried she wouldn't be able to get out of the house to buy a gift for her daughter. Thanks to Mission Christmas, Amy received a gift which she and her mum spent a lot of time using together. The donations not only gave this child a new gift, but enabled her to make priceless memories.
